PREFLIGHT: The first thing your instructor will go over with you is the pre-flight which is where you will check the airplane and make sure it is airworthy and ready for flight. I have put a handout together for you to download. This is a basic outline you will have for you to refer to the POH (Pilot Operating Handbook) for your airplane. Every plane will vary a little bit depending on the model and manufacture. One thing you want to do is have a system. I have seen instructors and students go all over the place. They will check fuel, then brakes... on and on. You want to start in one spot, work your way around the plane and end up at that spot. That way you won't miss anything. Use the handout below to help you. Remember to use the POH for your airplane.
